- Boats are to take their own finish time corrected to Eastern Standard Time and text
 the time to Race Control on 0498 256 428. The text is to include the corrected finish
 time, boat in front (where possible) and boat behind (where possible).
- Boats must adhere to Clause 16.4 as though the finish boat was on station.
- After finishing a boat must also contact Race Control on the VHF Race Channel (Ch
 72) and advise of their finish and also relay their finish time.
